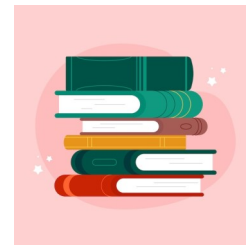


Dear Parents, Students and Community Members

NATIONAL SIMULTANEOUS READING ACTIVITY

Grace Polito from Year 3 Lime read the story 'Bowerbird Blues' written by Aura Parker, to the whole school over the PA at 11:00am on Wednesday 22 May, as we celebrated National Simultaneous Reading Day. 2024 is the 24th year of the National Simultaneous Reading Day. On this day we joined 2,359,147 participants at 21,969 locations across Australia. Activities related to the story were available for children to complete after the reading and this supports our Reading for Meaning school priority.

SunSmart Message

X marks the spot so check your skin regularly to pick up any changes that might suggest a skin cancer. Look for any crusty, non healing sores, small lumps that are red, pale or pearly in colour and new spots, freckles or any moles that change in colour, thickness or shape over a period of weeks to months (especially those that are dark brown to black, red or blue – black).

Protection from the sun involves five simple steps – slip, slop, slap, seek and slide.



Vision and eyes

Good vision is important for learning and quality of life. Watch for any of the following in your child:

- covering/closing one eye when reading
- holding books very close
- complaining of eyestrain or headache
- complaining of double vision or blurred vision with reading or board viewing
- complaining of words moving on a page
- losing place when reading, or skipping words and lines
- inattention or short attention span when reading, or
- rubbing the eyes.

Please note: Medicare covers the cost of an eye examination. If you have a concern about your child's vision please contact a doctor, optometrist or your local Community Health Nurse.

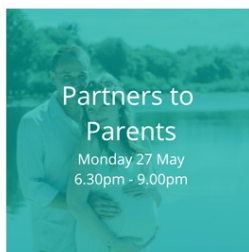
