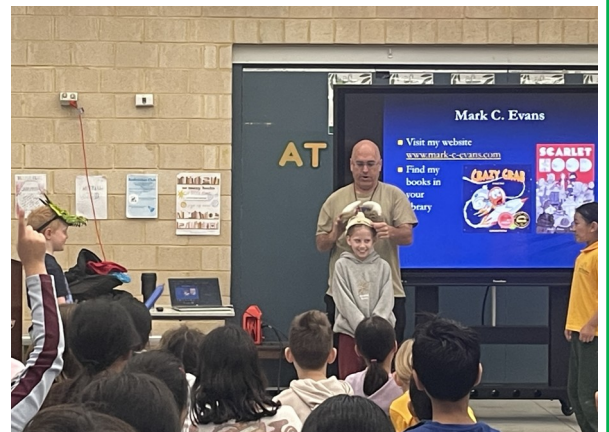
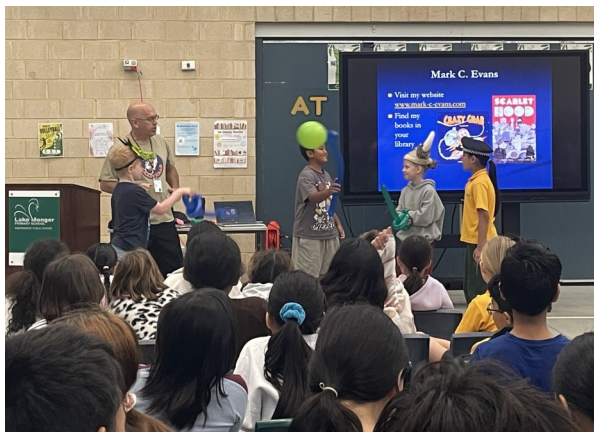

Layer sunscreen on thickly 20 minutes before going out in the sun and reapply sunscreen every two hours.

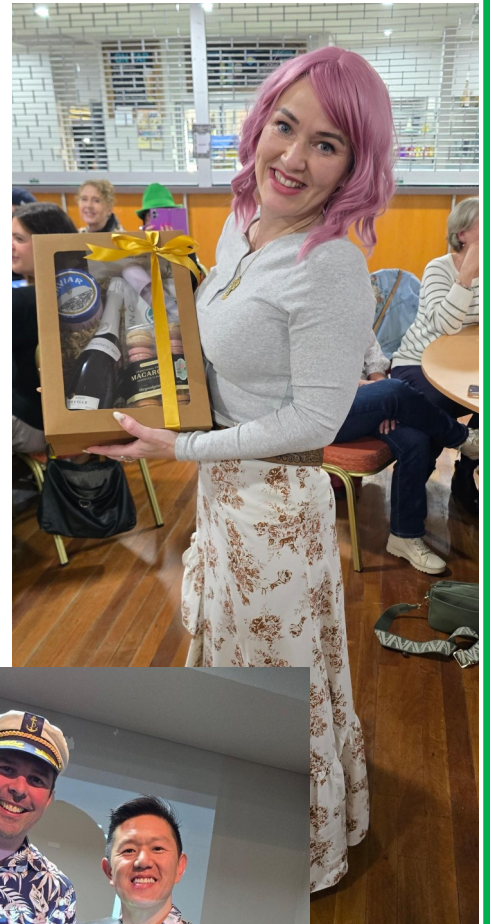
